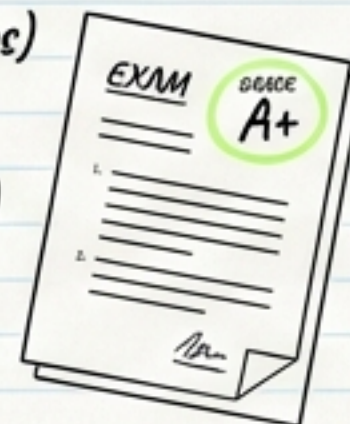
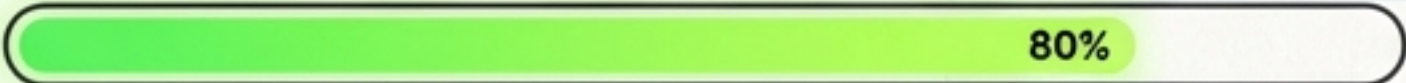

(Use Rhetorical Questions, Anecdotes)

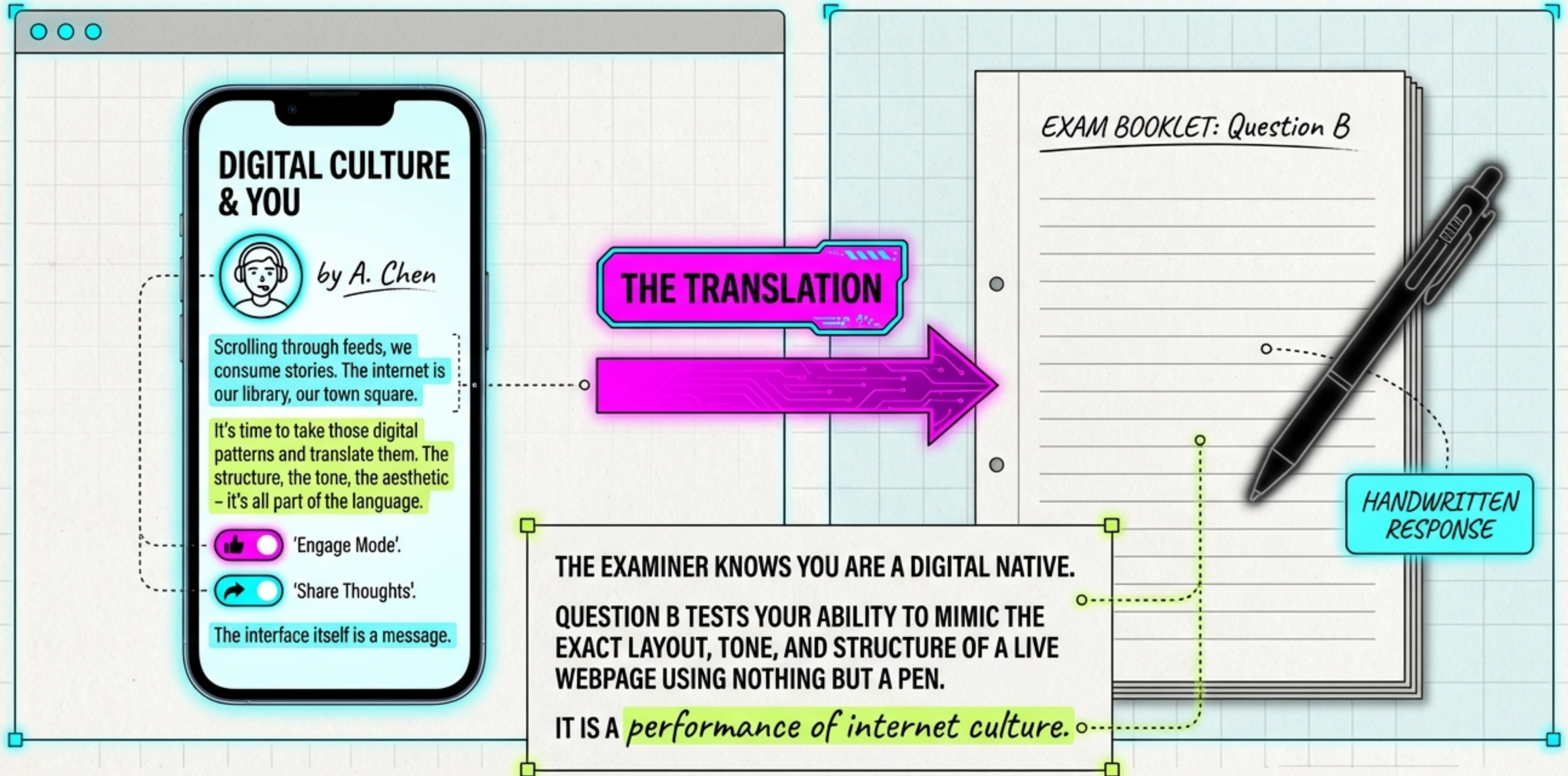
Step 4: Integrate Evidence

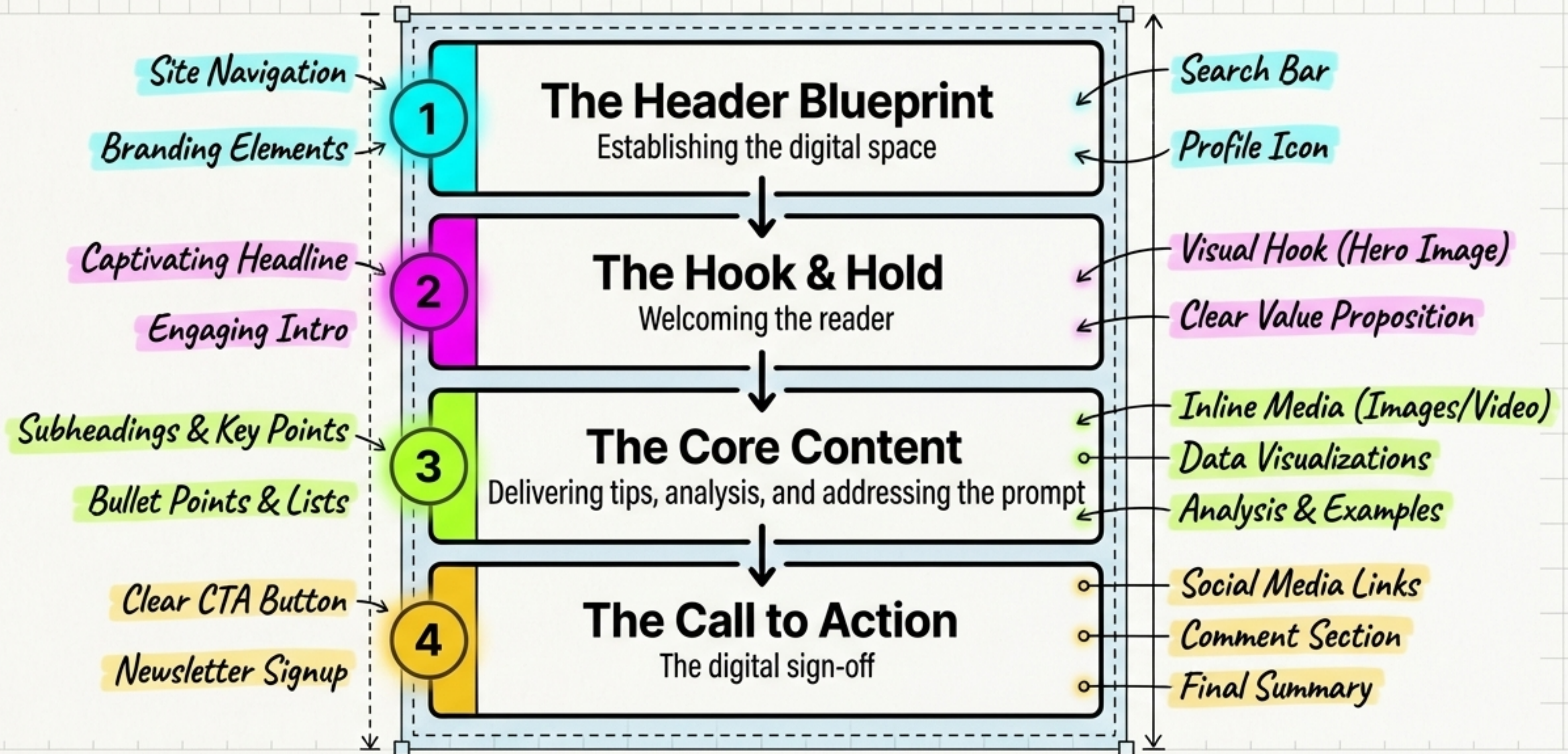

The 4-Step Page Architecture



Step 1: Prove you are online in the first three lines

Website / Blog Name

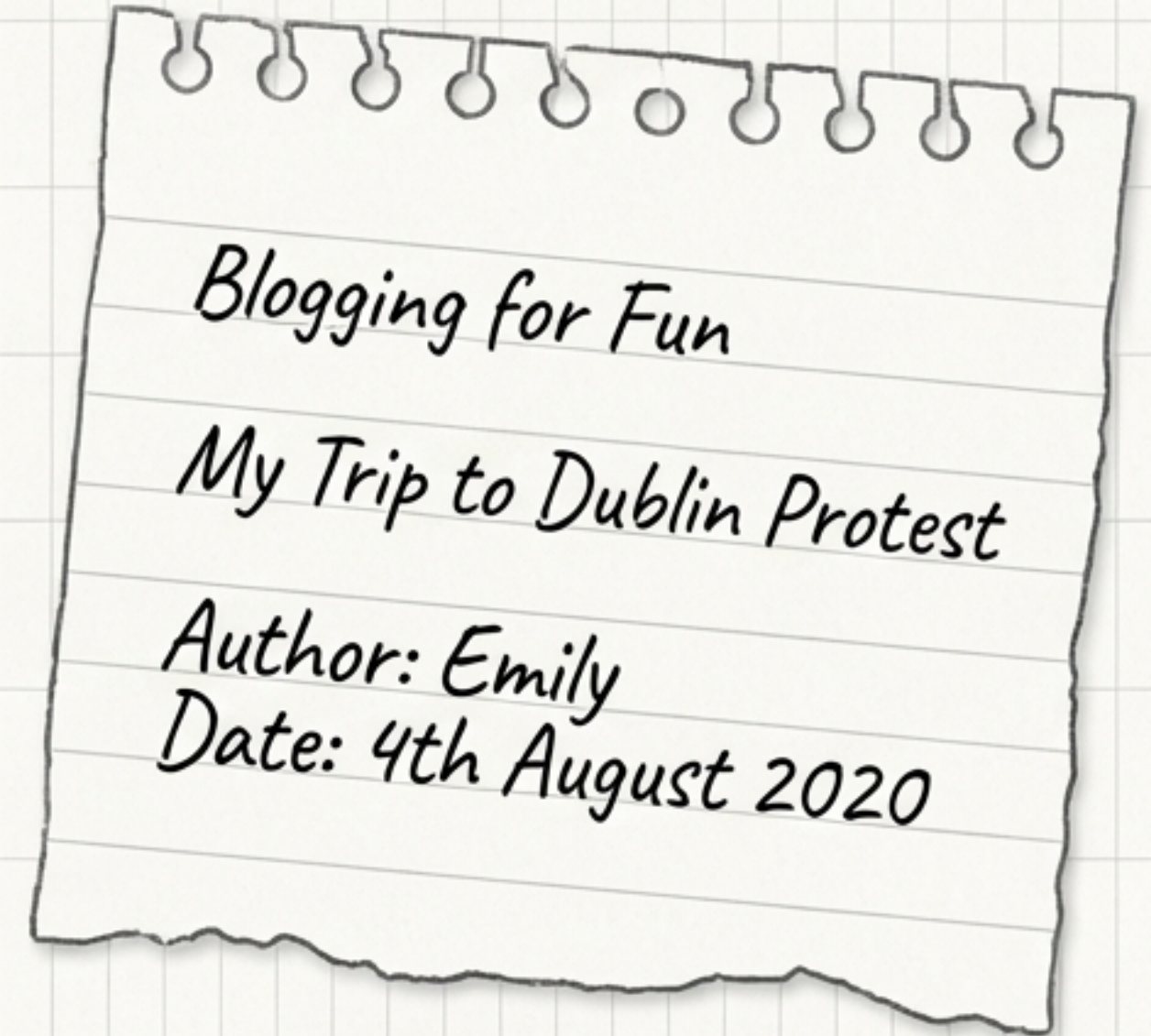
(e.g., *Diary of a professional footballer wannabe*)

Specific Post Title

(e.g., *How to be a better football player*)

Author Name + Date

(e.g., *Author: Ben | Date: 14th August 2020*)



Placing these three elements immediately signals to the examiner that you are fulfilling the core purpose of Question B.

Step 2: The Hook and Hold Funnel



Box the prompt to build your layout

Explain **how you got to Dublin and how you felt** on the journey, **describe the atmosphere of the event** and **encourage your readers to do more** to help reduce their carbon emissions.

Paragraph 1:

Paragraph 2:

*Thousands
chanting, calm
and civil, petitions.*

Paragraph 3:

*Practical steps
(cycling, public
transport).*

Step 3: Populate the body with tips, analysis, and personality



Give Practical Tips

Pre-match meals should be based on carbohydrates like pasta... sleep is really important for recovery.



Engage the Audience directly

Look at the Spanish players we see every week... if it's good enough for Ronaldo, it's good enough for you.



Use Powerful Quotes

Like Greta Thunberg once wisely said, "we can no longer save the world by playing by the rules".

Step 4: Build a handwritten Call to Action button

The internet is interactive. Don't just summarize; tell your reader exactly what to do next.
